Annual Activity Report 2008-2009

OPENING REMARKS:

The College goes back to the year 1955 when India, particularly the state of Punjab, was making efforts to carry education to every village, not even represented on its educational map. 70% of B.Ed. seats are reserved for the students belonging to rural area of Punjab. Motive of college is thus upliftment of rural women.

NOMINATIONS AND RECOGNITIONS:

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:

a) ADMISSIONS:

The college provides instruction in Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) and Master of Education (M.Ed.) courses of Panjab University, Chandigarh. The admission to the B.Ed. course is done on the basis of Joint Entrance Test conducted every year by one of the three universities in the state and the admission to M.Ed. course is done through entrance test conducted by Panjab University.

70% of the total number of seats of B.Ed. in this college is offered to girls who are always at a disadvantage academically, having been educated in rural areas. The Government of Punjab has already issued a notification to this effect.

RESULTS:

248 B.Ed. students appeared for the examination and all the students passed with first division. 5 students scored above 75% marks and 30 students scored above 70% marks. In the annual B.Ed. examination Ishatpreet bagged first position in the college and in the annual M.Ed. examination of Panjab University, Chandigarh, Jasdeep bagged the first position in the college. All the M.Ed. students passed with first division. In M.Ed. 6 students scored above 80% marks and 11 students scored above 75% marks.

STUDENTS' CENTRAL ASSOCIATION:

The Students' Central Association with Neha as the College Head Girl and Sukhjeet as the Hostel Head Girl has been efficiently functioning during the academic session 2010-2011.

LIBRARY AND BOOK BANK:

At present the library has 20666 books and around 300 new titles were added to the stock this year. We subscribe to 130 journals of educational and general interest. 12 students availed of the facility of the Book Bank during the current year. We received 367 gifted titles from Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore.

ACTIVITIES AND FUNCTIONS ORGANIZED:

- Teacher's day was celebrated on September 5, 2008 with full vigour and vitality. The faculty member enlightened the students about the various qualities of a good teacher.
