The admission to the B.Ed. course for session 2011-12 was done through centralized online counselling process and on the basis of merit in qualifying examination as per the rules of Panjab University, Chandigarh (First counselling was done from 10/8/2011 to 23/8/2011, Second counselling was done from 29/8/2011 to 2/9/2011, and Third counselling was held on 8/9/2011) and the admission to M.Ed. course was done on the basis of entrance test conducted by Panjab University, Chandigarh from 27/09/2011 to 01/10/2011. INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME:

RESULTS:

The students of 2010-2011 session who are present in the pandal today, waiting to receive their degrees deserve a resounding applause for the commendable results. 245 B.Ed. students appeared for the Annual examination of Panjab University, Chandigarh. All got first division and 40 students got above 75%. Kamaldeep Kaur bagged first position in the college by securing 886 marks. Rikmandeep bagged second position in the college by securing 874 marks. In the annual M.Ed. examination of Panjab University, 31 students appeared. All got first division, 5 students got above 80%. Ishatpreet Kaur got second position in Panjab University with 84%. Payal Sood and Sonia Wadhwa bagged sixth position in Panjab University with 82%.

STUDENTS' CENTRAL ASSOCIATION:

The Students' Central Association with Kamakshi Dutta as the College Head Girl and Ravinder Kaur as the Hostel Head Girl has been efficiently functioning during the academic session 2011-2012.

LIBRARY AND BOOK BANK:

At present the library has 23047 books and around 420 new titles were added to the stock this year. We received 93 gifted titles from Khalsa Dewan, Ludhiana and 43 from Publication Bureau, P.U. Chandigarh.
