## **OPENING REMARKS**

The college completed first Pre-Ph.D. course in June 2013. Research scholars from different colleges visit the college for research work. Facility of library and Psychology laboratory is provided by the college for these scholars. Faculty members (Dr. Naginder Kaur, Dr. Mohua Khosla, Dr. Avninder Preet Singh, and Dr. Gurmit Singh) also are available for consultancy to the research scholars visiting the college.

## **ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:**

### **a) ADMISSIONS:**

The college provides instruction in Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) and Master of Education (M.Ed.) courses of PanjabUniversity, Chandigarh. The admission to the B.Ed. course for session 2013-2014 was done through Centralized Online Counselling process and on the basis of merit in qualifying examination as per the rules of Panjabi University, Patiala and the admission to M.Ed. course was done on the basis of entrance test conducted by PanjabUniversity, Chandigarh.

70% of the total number of seats of B.Ed. in this college is offered to girls who are always at a disadvantage academically, having been educated in rural areas. The Government of Punjab has already issued a notification to this effect.

**INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME:**

- Teaching Practice of B.Ed. students I phase from 19 October 2013 to 23 November 2013 and II phase from 5 May 2014 to 17 May 2014. Students were sent to 16 (Government and Government –aided) schools selected from Ludhiana along with their teacher incharge.

- Skill in teaching examination of B.Ed. students were held from 22/05/2014 to 24/05/2014.

#### **RESULTS:**

248 B.Ed. students appeared for the Annual examination of Panjab University, Chandigarh. All got first division and 4 students got above 80%. Jaspreet Kaur bagged first position in the college by securing 903 marks. In the annual M.Ed. examination of Panjab University, 34 students appeared. All got first division and 9 students secured above 80% marks. Our students bagged six out of first ten University positions. Anupama Sidanabagged the I position with 86% marks, Sanam Dawar the II, Alka Joshi the III, Inderdeep Kaur bagged the IV, Aditi Gupta the V, Surpinder Kaur and Daljeet Rani bagged the VII position.

The most progressive feature of the college is the active participation of students in the organization of the college activities. We subscribe to 73 journals of educational and general interest. 15 students availed of the facility of Book Bank during the current year.
