INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME:

RESULTS

250 B.Ed. students appeared for the Annual examination of Panjab University, Chandigarh. All got first division and Chanpreet Kaur (Roll No.2133) bagged 1st Position in Panjab University by securing 85.54% (941/1100) and Taranjot Kaur (Roll No.2127) bagged 2nd position in the college by securing 81.64% (898/1100). 135 students got above 70%, 45 above 75%, 5 above 80% and 1 student got above 85% marks.

In the annual M.Ed. examination of Panjab University, 35 students appeared. All got first division and brought laurels to the college by bagging five out of first ten University positions. Priya Arora bagged the I position with 86.76% marks, Nidhi stood III, Navpreet Kaur-V, Gifty-VII and Jasdeep Kaur bagged the VIII position. 33 students got above 70%, 27 above 75%, 11 above 80% and 4 students got 85% marks.
