

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The Alumni Association of Malwa Central College of Education for Women strives to connect and unite former students of the institution at least twice a year and also invites them for attending various functions of the college from time to time and foster a lasting community.

Its key functions include networking, mentoring and offering career support for teacher trainees along with fundraising, event organization and advocacy to support the institutional goals and enhance its reputation.

Association also conducts community service programmes. It organizes food drives, clothing donations, and free classes for children to uplift underwhelming communities.

The alumni members are also invited time to time for guiding students in the orientation week to acquaint the new entrants with the knowledge and skills required to excel in the teaching professions. They are also exposed to the expectations of the society in these lectures.

COMPOSITION OF ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The prime purpose to establish the Alumni Association is to maintain connections with the former students and promoting their responsible attitude towards the institution and society at large on the one side and to awaken the future teachers about the profession as a whole at the other side

The governing body of the Alumni Association consists of five office bearers consisting of patron, teacher In-charge and four student office bearers. These are chosen on the basis of democratic principles i.e. on the basis of open voting.

First of all, the aspiring candidate nominates themselves or someone else proposes their names, followed by voting and candidates getting maximum votes are chosen as the office bearers.

All the decisions of the society are taken on the basis of majority votes by following democratic principles. The governing body of the society has the following structure:
